

RESOLUTION: R24-93

Authorizing grant of funds to Sun Valley General Improvement District

WHEREAS, NRS 244.1505 provides that a Board of County Commissioners may expend money for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County and that a board may make a grant of money to certain nonprofit organizations or governmental entities created for religious, charitable or educational purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County has determined that a certain amount of money is available from the ARPA fund passed through to Sun Valley General Improvement District will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of Washoe County;

WHEREAS, Sun Valley General Improvement District legal status is as a nonprofit corporation created for educational or charitable purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY, that the Board hereby awards

1. Sun Valley General Improvement District, a grant in the amount of \$60,000.00.
2. The purpose of the SLFRF- ARPA funded program is Sun Valley General Improvement District to support projects consist of sealing and striping of the parking lot, walking paths, and basketball court at Highland Ranch Park. This would also support purchase and installation of security camera's at Gepford Park, and picnic benches, in the amount of \$60,000
3. The maximum amount to be expended from the grant and the conditions and limitations upon the grant are set forth in the Subgrant Agreement that will be signed by the County Manager.
