Summary for September 2024

September 2024 was a busy month for TMFR Firefighters, including a major incident, the Davis Fire. Of 35 fire responses, 12 were wildfire-related, and eight fires outside of the Davis Fire, involved structures.

LARGE/MAJOR EVENTS:

September 2024 was largely about the Davis Fire which started on the afternoon of Saturday, September 7 and was declared 100 percent contained on September 25. This was a major fire that attracted national attention. Fire crews from 23 states responded totaling more than 700 personnel. A total of 14 residential structures were lost, 2 commercial buildings, and 22 outbuildings. There was no loss of life.

9/22/24: TMFR Firefighters suppressed a travel trailer fire on Franks Lane in Sun Valley. The structure was a total loss. No injuries reported.

9/27/24: TMFR Firefighters responded to a large barn fire on Silver Knolls off of Red Rock Road. There was a minor injury to the resident.





Incident Total for September 2024: 1094








