POSSIBLE ACTION

SUMMARY

This item is presented seeking approval to accept the grant award from Our Rescue.

Per County policy, the Washoe Board of County Commissioners must accept grant awards and must approve amendments to the adopted fiscal year budget and direct Finance to make the necessary budget amendments.

This grant has been awarded to the Washoe County Sheriff's Office for the purchase of a one-year subscription to Virtual Investigation Platform (VIP) Lite software to create online personas or profiles that will be used for the Human Exploitation and Recovery Operations (HERO) detectives to complete open-source investigations and intelligence gathering and allow the detectives to have undercover social media platforms to conduct investigations.

Washoe County Strategic Objective supported by this item: Vulnerable Populations: Support vulnerable populations with a regional approach

PREVIOUS ACTION

This is the first time the Washoe County Sheriff's Office has received grant funding from Our Rescue.

BACKGROUND

This grant has been awarded to the Washoe County Sheriff's Office for one annual subscription to Virtual Investigation Platform (VIP) Lite for use by our Human

Exploitation and Recovery Operations (HERO) unit, who combat human trafficking and exploitation through prosecution, protection, and prevention. The unit investigates and arrests traffickers, provides support for survivors, and raises public awareness.

VIP is a software as a service platform that provides a single environment for easy access, security, and confidentiality for our digital investigators. It is designed with security and accessibility in mind and does not require the user to access a separate standalone system for doing research, while still ensuring operational security for the user. VIP is accessible via a web browser from any computer, tablet, or smartphone that has an internet connection, allowing our digital investigators to continue their work from anywhere.

VIP is designed to leave no digital trail for the user, to keep persona accounts alive, and to make management of these as easy as possible. It is designed to scale and scale quickly, which means we can have the tool with all its features match the size of our teams at any given time. Outsourcing this solution to a commercial company lets us focus on core business functions like investigation and analysis, saving time and boosting productivity.
