<u>RESOLUTION</u> – Authorizing the Grant of Public Monies to a Nonprofit Organization Created for Religious, Charitable or Educational Purposes

WHEREAS, NRS 244.1505 provides that the Board of County Commissioners may expend money for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County and that a board may make a grant of money to a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes or to a governmental entity to be expended for a selected purpose; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County, upon the recommendation of Commissioner Mariluz Garcia for District 3, has determined that \$2,500.00 will be granted to Sleep in Heavenly Peace to support the mission that no child should have to sleep on the floor; and

WHEREAS, Sleep in Heavenly Peace builds and delivers beds to children who don't have one, including a mattress, sheets, blankets, and pillows; and

WHEREAS, Sleep in Heavenly Peace had its start, like many charities, in a garage. What began as one bed for one child in need has grown to over 300,000 beds provided with the hope that no child has to sleep on the floor; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**, By the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County that:

- 1. The Board hereby grants Sleep in Heavenly Peace a grant for fiscal year 2025-2026 in the amount of \$2,500.00.
- 2. The Board finds that in making this grant a substantial benefit will be provided to the residents in Washoe County by meeting the needs of our growing community, supporting a thriving community, and strengthening our culture of service.
- 3. The funds shall not be used to purchase tickets to special events.
- 4. All funding provided under this resolution must be expended for the specified purpose within 12 months of the date of the resolution's approval.
