

**Amendment #1 to the
Truckee Meadows Fire and Rescue Service Agreement**

by and between

**Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District
and
Northern Nevada Medical Center and Northern Nevada Sierra Medical Center**

This Amendment #1 is made as of the date of the last signature below (“Effective Date”) by and between Northern Nevada Medical Center and Northern Nevada Sierra Medical Center (hereinafter referred to as “Northern Nevada Health System”), and Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District (hereinafter referred to as “TMFPD” or “Provider”).

WHEREAS, Northern Nevada Health System and TMFPD entered into a Truckee Meadows Fire and Rescue Service Agreement dated July 11, 2023 (the “Agreement”);

WHEREAS, the parties wish to amend the Agreement, which is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the recitals above, the parties agree to be legally bound as follows:

1. Section 4 of the Agreement, entitled “Billing”, is hereby revised to read as follows:

“Subject to the terms of Addendum A hereof, Provider shall bill Northern Nevada Health System for those transports that Northern Nevada Health System has assumed responsibility of payment for including transports not covered by insurance or government payors, at the most current rates approved by the Washoe County District Board of Health as of the date of service. Northern Nevada Health System shall pay Provider for billed charges within thirty (30) days of invoice date. With the exception of emergent transfers, Provider will provide a 30% discount from billed charges for any transport not covered by insurance or government payors or where payment is deemed to be Northern Nevada Health System’s responsibility. Emergent transfers shall be paid at 100% of the billed charges without discount. If not paid within 45 days of the invoice date, Northern Nevada Health System agrees to pay the full billed charges.

For transports where Northern Nevada Health System is the payor, Provider must submit invoices for such transports to Northern Nevada Health System no later than sixty (60) days following its performance of such transports. If an invoice for the applicable transport is not received by Northern Nevada Health

System within sixty (60) days following Provider's performance of the underlying billed transport, Provider waives its right to receive payment for such transport and Northern Nevada Health System shall not be required to pay for such transport. In addition, all invoices for transports where Northern Nevada Medical Center is the payor occurring during a calendar year must be received by Northern Nevada Medical Center no later than January 31 of the following calendar year. If an invoice for such a transport is not received by Northern Nevada Health System before that time, Provider waives its right to receive payment for such transport and Northern Nevada Health System shall not be required to pay for such transport."

2. Section 3(b) of Addendum A to the agreement, entitled "Billing to Northern Nevada Health System" is hereby revised to read as follows:

Billing to Northern Nevada Health System. Where Northern Nevada Health System is required by law or where Northern Nevada Health System has agreed to be responsible for payment, as described herein, Provider will bill Northern Nevada Health System directly for transports rendered to patients of Northern Nevada Health System. Provider shall bill Northern Nevada Health System in such circumstances at the rates currently approved by the Washoe County District Board of Health as of the date of service. Northern Nevada Health System shall pay Provider for billed charges within thirty (30) days of invoice date. With the exception of emergent transfers, Provider will provide a 30% discount from billed charges for any transport not covered by insurance or government payors or where payment is deemed to be Northern Nevada Health System's responsibility. If not paid within 45 days of the invoice date, Northern Nevada Health System agrees to pay the full billed charges.

For transports where Northern Nevada Health System is the payor, Provider must submit invoices for such transports to Northern Nevada Health System no later than sixty (60) days following its performance of such transports. If an invoice for the applicable transport is not received by Northern Nevada Health System within sixty (60) days following Provider's performance of the underlying billed transport, Provider waives its right to receive payment for such transport and Northern Nevada Health System shall not be required to pay for such transport. In addition, all invoices for transports where Northern Nevada Health System is the payor occurring during a calendar year must be received by Northern Nevada Health System no later than January 31 of the following calendar year. If an invoice for such a transport is not received by Northern Nevada Health System before that time, Provider waives its right to receive payment for such transport and Northern Nevada Health System shall not be required to pay for such transport."

3. Section 3(c) of Addendum A to the agreement is hereby revised to read as follows:

Emergent transfers shall be paid at 100% of the billed charges without discount.

An emergent transfer is defined as a transfer that is necessary to provide time-sensitive intervention for critically ill patients. This includes patients with STEMI or stroke who require immediate medical attention. The transfer process involves specific criteria and protocols to ensure the patient's safety and the quality of care during transport.

4. This Amendment #1 extends the term of the agreement for an additional period of three (3) years from the expiration date of the Agreement (July 11, 2026).
5. All other provisions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
