Final Election Update: As of 11/14 at 3:48PM

334,118 Active Registered Voters

*Total Turnout 264,333 or **79.1%**

In-Person Voting Votes Cast

Early Voting: 93,110

Election Day: 40,349

6,895 provisional voters – **5,874** validly cast provisional ballots counted 11/12

39.95% of the total vote is in person based on total active reg. voters

51% of the total turnout is in-person

Election Results Update

11/14: All validly cast ballots entered into the count at 3:48PM

- In-person
- Mail ballots
- Military/overseas citizens
- ADA/Tribal
- Provisionals

*Note: Both in-person and mail ballot **turnout** will account for only **validly cast ballots** tabulated on election night and up to the end of canvass on 11/15 if/as needed.

Mail Ballot Processing

130,874 Mail Ballots Counted

39.17% of the total vote is by mail ballot based on total active reg. voters

Total ballots **already cured**: 1,875

Total ballots **uncured by voters**: 1,034

49% of the total turnout is by mail ballot

Timeline

11/14 **Post Logic and Accuracy testing** of tabulators (scanned in 6,780 test ballots) with Certification Board & Public Observation – completed at 6:51PM

11/15 BCC meeting at 10AM **Canvass of the vote**/certification of election result

11/20 **Last day** to request a recount

Mail Ballots Signature Curing & Reporting (NRS 293.269927)

Curing a challenged mail ballot was available until Nov. 12 at 5PM

5 Ways to Cure

1. Visit in person: 1001 E. 9th St., Reno, NV. 89512
2. Call our office: 775-328-3670
3. Mail: Complete and return the Cure Affidavit
4. Text2Cure: On a mobile device, text "Washoe" to 28683
5. Scan QR Code:



ROV called, emailed, and mailed cure affidavits to challenged voters

Work with political parties and vendors to improve signature curing reporting

Undeliverable Ballots: Primary & General (NRS 293.269913)

- Election mail ballots are **not forwardable** and must be returned to the ROV office
- Receiving an **undeliverable mail ballot back** serves as an indicator to send an address confirmation card
 - This **initiates** the process to inactivate a voter
- Undeliverable Ballots per Election
 - **2024 Primary: 25,000**
 - **2024 General: *22,000**

*10,000 voters updated their records or voted and 12,000 will be sent an address confirmation card in March 2025



Voter Roll List Maintenance “Inactivations” (NRS 293.530)

List Maintenance Process “Inactivations”

- When official election mail or correspondence comes back as **undeliverable**
- Triggering an **address confirmation card** to be sent
- When our office **does not receive a response** or the voter does not update their record **after 33-days, inactivation occurs**

Bulk Voter Roll List Maintenance Schedule

2/20/2025 - Bulk inactivations of final remaining **8,628** voters

3/14/2025 – Begin to send address confirmation cards for undeliverable ballots from 2024 November General Election **12,198** (starts the 33-day clock)

4/16/2025 – **Earliest date to start voter inactivations**- voters that didn't respond or take action on their voter record after the card was sent





Inactivations Timeline

*48,000 Voter Address confirmation cards sent June 2024

19,000 Actions were taken by ROV to update voter records in Aug. 2024

29,000 cards were actionable, but deadline was missed for Aug. 2024

7,500 voters updated their records

21,500 are currently inactive

(8,600 voters were inactivated on 2/20/25)

Voter Roll List Maintenance “Cancellations” (NRS 293.530)

Initiated 3-Ways

1. Voter takes proactive action to cancel their record
2. Nevada SOS/ERIC reports
3. Bulk voter list maintenance

List Maintenance Process “Cancellations”

- ROV sends a forwardable notice to the active voter
- If voter does not respond or the notice comes back undeliverable, voter is inactivated
- Voter does not update their record or vote within 2 Federal General elections
- The Inactive voter is Cancelled

***Bulk Voter Roll List Maintenance Schedule** *Does not include daily list maintenance

3/28/2025 - Schedule for bulk Cancellations (currently working on analysis)

3/26/2027 – Schedule for future bulk Cancellations



(EIVR) Election Integrity Violation Reports (NAC 293.025)

"To ensure concerns are appropriately investigated and addressed, in accordance with applicable statutes and regulations, any person may raise concerns about the election process by submitting their perceived concerns of **Election Integrity Violations in writing to the Secretary of State.**"

ROV addresses frequently asked questions regarding election administration, processes, practices, and procedures without filing an EIVR.

Current EIVR Status

113 Washoe County-related EIVRs submitted during 2024 election cycle per SOS compliance team (as of 1/17/25):

79 EIVRs closed for no NRS Title 24 Elections violation

- ROV responded to 15 needing further investigation - back with SOS

34 EIVRs are open and actively being investigated by SOS w/no current action required by Washoe County

The Elections Group – Recommendations

- The Elections Group Audit 2023
- 68 categories with 122 recommendations
