MISSION

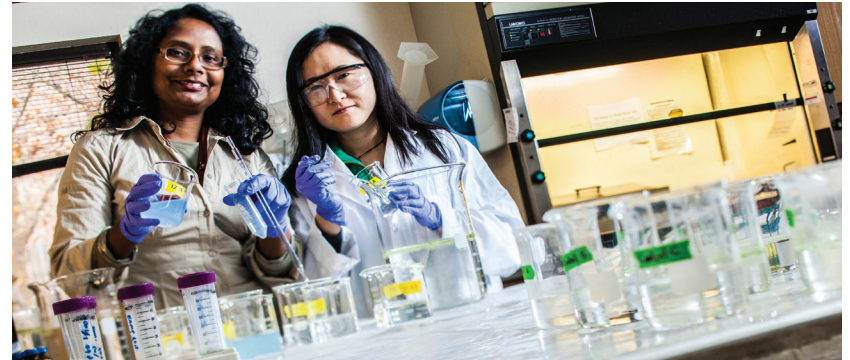
