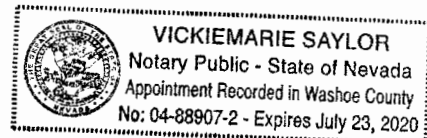

**NOTICE OF INTENT TO INCREASE WASHOE COUNTY'S 911
TELEPHONE LINE SURCHARGE**

NOTICE OF PUBLIC WORKSHOPS

And

**Request for data or arguments concerning a proposed increase to
Washoe County's 911 telephone line surcharge
(Washoe County Code ("WCC") 65.450)**

The Washoe County Board of County Commissioners will consider an increase to the 911 telephone line surcharge. This increase will help recover the costs of a Portable Event Recorder Program (body-worn and vehicle-mounted cameras) for regional uniformed peace officers, as required and authorized by NRS 289.830, as amended by Nevada Senate Bill ("SB") 176 (2017). The proposed increase will support Portable Event Recorder Programs for the City of Reno Police Department, the City of Sparks Police Department, the Washoe County Sheriff's Office and the City of Reno and City of Sparks Municipal Courts Marshals.

Washoe County's 911 telephone line surcharge is currently set at \$0.25 per month for each customer access line to the local exchange of a telecommunications provider; \$0.25 per month for each telephone number assigned a customer by a supplier of mobile telephone service (including VoIP); and \$2.50 per month for each customer trunk line to the local exchange of a telecommunications provider. In accordance with SB 176, the 911 telephone line surcharge may be increased in an amount up to: \$1.00 per month for each customer access line to the local exchange; \$1.00 per month for each telephone number assigned to a customer of mobile telephone service (including VoIP); and \$10.00 per month for each customer trunk line to the local exchange of a telecommunications provider. This is a potential increase of up to \$0.75 per month for access lines and mobile telephone numbers (including VoIP) and a potential increase of up to \$7.50 for trunk lines.

In compliance with NRS 237.080, local governments are to notify trade associations or owners and officers of businesses that are likely to be affected by the increase of a surcharge. Trade associations or owners and officers of businesses may submit data or arguments to the local government's governing body, or its designee, if adoption of the proposed surcharge increase will either: (a) impose a direct and significant economic burden upon a business, or (b) directly restrict the formation, operation or expansion of a business.

As a telecommunications service provider or business owner, the proposed increase to the 911 telephone line surcharge may impact your business or business operations. You are encouraged to provide any comments, arguments or data on whether an increased 911 telephone line surcharge will impose a direct and significant economic burden upon your business or directly restrict the formation, operation, or expansion of your business.
