SUMMARY

The Washoe County Sheriff's Office has received donations in the total amount of \$100.00 from Robert and Diana Wellems. These donations will be used for the purchase of equipment for the K-9 Unit at the Sheriff's Office.

PREVIOUS ACTION

The Board accepted a similar monetary donation from a private citizen on May 16, 2017.

BACKGROUND

The Sheriff's Office occasionally receives donations from private citizens, some for specific units. This donation will be used for the purchase of equipment for the K-9 Unit, as requested by the donor.
