

RECOMMENDATION

Accept Supplement Number 2 in the amount of \$180,000 to the Grant Award (G17NV0001A) for the High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) from the Office of National Drug Control Policy (ONDCP); augment the budget for the grant award amount; and authorize the Sheriff to sign the agreement; or take other action as appropriate.

FISCAL IMPACT

The Office of National Drug Control Policy cooperative agreement G17NV0001A has been increased by \$180,000 and now totals \$3,240,000. Matching funds are not required for this grant program.

DISCUSSION

On February 27, 2017, the Fiscal Affairs Committee approved the 2017 award for the HIDTA program in the amount of \$1,753,380. On July 24, 2017, the Fiscal Affairs committee approved Supplement Number 1 in the amount of \$1,306,630 for a total of \$3,060,000. This supplemental funding in the amount of \$180,000 will bring the total award amount to \$3,240,000.

The Federal government mandates one of the participating agencies in a HIDTA program serve as fiscal agent. Participating agencies, along with the LVMPD, include North Las Vegas Police Department, Henderson Police Department, Federal Bureau of Investigation, Drug Enforcement Administration, Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco & Firearms, Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE), U.S. Marshals Service, U.S. Attorney's Office, Internal Revenue Service, Nevada Division of Investigations, Nevada Highway Patrol, Nevada Air National Guard, Clark County District Attorney's Office, Reno Police Department, Sparks Police Department, Washoe County Sheriff's Office, and Reno Tahoe Airport Authority. Grant funds will provide for overtime, computers and other equipment, travel, supplies and services to support nineteen initiatives. The grant period is from January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2018.
