### BACKGROUND

D.R. Horton, developer of a 93 unit subdivision along Mount Rose Highway at the intersection of Edmonton Drive has requested a modification of the parcel's wildfire designation, from high to moderate.

The Wildland Urban Interface Code (WUI) Guide, Building Construction Requirements, Table 503.1 Ignition-Resistant Construction provides the guidance for determining a reduction. There are 3 factors used to apply a reduction:

1. Existence of a conforming water supply
2. Defensible space
3. Ignition resistant construction

Staff's review of the submittal finds that each of the 3 factors is addressed. The subdivision will have a water supply consisting of a water system supplying hydrants. Defensible space is created through landscaping of each lot that removes high hazard fuels and replaces it with irrigated landscaping and street network, and the entire parcel is surrounded by pavement and rip-rap. Ignition resistant building materials are used on walls and roofs.
