

## RESOLUTION OF THE RENO-SPARKS TRIBAL COUNCIL

- WHEREAS, the Reno-Sparks Tribal Council is organized pursuant to the provisions of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984, 25 U.S.C. 476), as amended, to provide for certain rights of home rule and to be responsible for the general welfare of its membership; and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to the inherent power and authority vested to the Reno-Sparks Tribal Council by the Constitution and Bylaws of the Reno-Sparks Indian Colony, the Tribal Council has the authority to adopt resolutions for the purpose of carrying out necessary governmental functions of the Reno-Sparks Indian Colony; and
- WHEREAS, the Reno-Sparks Indian Colony desires to update the Regional Multi-Hazard Mitigation plan; and
- WHEREAS, The Reno-Sparks Indian Colony desires to enter into the Regional Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan Donation agreement with Washoe County to pool government resources funding together to apply for the FEMA post-disaster and mitigation project funding; and
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Reno-Sparks Tribal Council hereby approves the Regional Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan Donation agreement in the amount of \$2,500,00.
