#### **SUMMARY**

The Regional Medical Examiner's Office requests that the Board approve the agreement between Washoe County and Tehama County for forensic pathology services provided by the Washoe County Regional Medical Examiner's Office for a period of up to three years effective retroactively on October 1, 2018.

### **PREVIOUS ACTION**

#### **BACKGROUND**

The Regional Medical Examiner's Office provides forensic autopsies, medical examinations, and medicolegal consultations to twenty agencies outside of Washoe County. In 2008, formal Interlocal Agreements were created between Washoe County and each of these counties/agencies. The agreements were renewed in 2014 and 2017. In March 2017, the Board approved a new fee schedule for the services covered by these agreements. The agreement is retroactively effective on October 1, 2018 due to the time necessary for all parties to review the agreement and agree to terms.

#### FISCAL IMPACT

The Regional Medical Examiner's Office anticipates revenues generated by this interlocal agreement to be \$10,000 in Fiscal Year 2019. Revenues received from this agency will be deposited to C153010-460341|Medical Examiner Fees and C153010-460318|Toxicology Fees.

#### **RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners approve the agreement between Washoe County and Tehama County for forensic pathology services provided by the Washoe County Regional Medical Examiner's Office for a period of up to three years effective retroactively on October 1, 2018.

#### **POSSIBLE MOTION**
