SUBJECT: Approve a Consolidated Bomb Squad 2018 grant [\$100,636.00, no match required] from the Nevada Division of Emergency Management, Federal FY 2018, project number 18-3000 to the Washoe County Sheriff's Office Bomb Unit for the purchase of equipment for the retroactive grant term of 9/1/18 through 8/31/20 and if approved, authorize Sheriff Allen to retroactively execute grant award documentation, direct Comptroller's Office to make the necessary budget amendments. SUMMARY

The Nevada Division of Emergency Management, through the Department of Homeland Security has awarded the WCSO funding for the purchase of equipment for the Bomb Unit.

PREVIOUS ACTION

Previous bomb division grant was approved by the Board on 11/14/17.

BACKGROUND

The Washoe County Sheriff's Office has been awarded a grant with the Nevada Division of Emergency Management, sub grant funds received through the Department of Homeland Security to the Washoe County Sheriff's Office for the purchase of updated equipment to replace the outdated and worn out equipment throughout FFY 2018. These funds were awarded for our Bomb Unit. Reason for retroactive submittal: Item was submitted to the first available BCC meeting once paperwork was received and processed.
