SUMMARY

The Nevada Division of Emergency Management, through the Department of Homeland Security has awarded the WCSO funding to sustain Cyber Security projects.

Washoe County Strategic Objective supported by this item: Safe, secure and healthy communities.

PREVIOUS ACTION

Previous Cyber Security grants were approved by the Board on 10/14/14; 10/13/15, 10/25/16, and 11/14/17.

BACKGROUND

The Washoe County Sheriff's Office has been awarded a grant with the Nevada Division of Emergency Management, sub grant funds received through the Department of Homeland Security to be used for various projects throughout Federal FY 2018. These funds were awarded for our Cyber Security unit to sustain travel and training requirements and to assist with software maintenance expenses associated with the advanced software needs. Reason for retroactive submittal: Item was submitted to the first available BCC meeting once all paperwork was received and processed.
