SUMMARY

A request has been made by the Washoe County Sheriff's Office for a \$500.00 increase to their Administrative Petty Cash Fund. This request has been reviewed and approved by both the Treasurer and the Comptroller.

Achieving Long Term Financial Sustainability

PREVIOUS ACTION

On August 28, 2012, the Board of County Commissioners approved a request to increase petty cash fund for the Washoe County Sheriff's Office from \$1,000 to \$1,500.

BACKGROUND

In 2011, the Comptroller's Office reduced the frequency of check runs from weekly to biweekly. The Sheriff's Office found it difficult to maintain sufficient funds in their petty cash fund due to the increased waiting time for replenishment checks.

The requested increase will enable them to maintain sufficient funding in between replenishment checks.
