

My name is Elvira Diaz. I am a community organizer living in District 30 of Sparks. I have lived in Nevada for fourteen years and in Sparks for ten years. I am a Latina immigrant from Mexico City, and I would be honored to serve on the Nevada State Assembly.

I am interested in the position to represent the Spanish-speaking community of Sparks. According to the last census, the Latino community represents nearly 30% of Sparks, yet we have little representation at the state level. In addition to serving as an advocate for the Latino community, I am also a proud ally of the LGBT community. I am raising a fourteen-year-old transgender son in District 30, and I would work to ensure the rights of students and others like him.

I am a member of the Nevada State Democratic Central Committee. For the past several elections, I have registered thousands of people to vote. I have also knocked on hundreds of doors on behalf of Democratic candidates cycle after cycle. This is the first time that I advocate for public office for myself.

If appointed, I would dedicate myself to increasing the participation of my community in the decisions made in District 30. Also, as a former business owner, I want to give direct access to resources to local businesses. I would like to promote the events that take place in the city of Sparks, help maintain the security of the area with better communications between police and the community, help reduce homelessness in the community, and address addiction issues.
