

RESOLUTION – Authorizing the Grant of Public Monies to a Government Entity

WHEREAS, NRS 244.1505 provides that a Board of County Commissioners may expend money for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County and that a board may make a grant of money to a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes or to a governmental entity to be expended for a selected purpose; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County upon the recommendation of Commissioner Jeanne Herman for District 5, has determined that \$1,500 is needed to support the Gerlach Fire Department in purchasing turnout gear for volunteer firefighters to be in compliance with National Fire Protection Association standards; and

WHEREAS, The Gerlach Fire Department's mission is to provide a safe, efficient and effective service to those that call that part of Washoe County home as well as visitors; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County that:

1. The Board finds that in making this grant, a substantial benefit will be provided to the inhabitants for the County by supporting the Gerlach Fire Department to outfit volunteer firefighters in appropriate turnout gear that is in compliance with National Fire Protection Association standards.
2. The Board hereby grants to the Gerlach Fire Department, a grant for fiscal year 2018-2019 in the amount of \$1,500 for the above purpose.
3. Funds shall not be used for the purchase of tickets to special events.
