<u>RESOLUTION</u> – Authorizing the Grant of Public Monies to a government entity.

WHEREAS, NRS 244.1505 provides that a Board of County Commissioners may expend money for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County and that a board may make a grant of money to a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes or to a governmental entity to be expended for a selected purpose; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County upon the recommendation of Commissioner Jeanne Herman for District 5, has determined that \$2,500 will be granted to the Board of Regents of the University of Nevada to support the Washoe County 4-H Livestock and Horse Leaders; and

WHEREAS, 4-H is the youth development education program of University of Nevada Cooperative Extension and is a community of young people across America learning leadership, citizenship and life skills; and

WHEREAS, 4-H participants, ages 5 to 19, take part in programs provided as the result of actions planned by Cooperative Extension personnel in cooperation with volunteers. 4-H offers youth opportunities in communications, leadership, career development, citizenship, healthy living, science, technology, engineering and math and more; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County that:

- The Board finds that in making this grant a substantial benefit will be provided to the inhabitants in Washoe County by supporting the Washoe County 4-H Livestock Leaders and the Washoe County 4-H Horse Leaders.
- The Board hereby grants to the Board of Regents of the University of Nevada a grant for fiscal year 2018-2019 in the amount of \$2,500 to support the Washoe County 4-H Livestock Leaders and the Washoe County 4-H Horse Leaders programs.
- 3. Funds shall not be used for the purchase of tickets to special events.
