

Action Plan:

- Three components:
 - 1. Programmatic
 - 2. Street Design/Infrastructure
 - 3. Community Engagement/Outreach
- Measurable Outcomes
- Used equitable, data-driven, transparent decisions and actions to improve safety throughout our community

Action Plan Goals


1. Programmatic - Adopt the goal of reaching zero fatalities by 2030

2. Street Design/Infrastructure – Develop a regional lighting standard and enhance street lighting to improve visibility throughout the Truckee Meadows

3. Community Engagement/Outreach – Recommend, pursue and establish Pedestrian Safety Zones








What's the Goal at Your House?

Share of victims who were killed or seriously injured






