My interest in serving on the Washoe County Open Space and Regional Parks Commission is twofold. First, I have spent my whole career working in the public interest and see this as an opportunity to apply my experience to the benefit of my home area. More specifically, serving on this Commission would enable me to contribute my past experience and skills in planning, programming, finance and public policy. Second, access to open space and parks, and the recreational opportunities that they provide, are a major reason why many of us chose to live in Washoe County. Accordingly, I am an outdoors enthusiast and thrive on being outdoors, whether I am hiking, backpacking, snowshoeing, backcountry skiing, kayaking, taking my grandchild to a County park playground, or simply, spending time outdoors with others for meals and visits. I am highly motivated to ensure that residents and visitors to Washoe County are also able to engage in outdoor activity and connect to each other and the natural environment around us.
