IRRIGATION WATER SYSTEM CONVEYANCE AGREEMENT

This Irrigation Water System Transfer Agreement is between Washoe County, a Nevada political subdivision ("<u>County</u>"), and Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe, a federally recognized Indian Tribe ("PLPT").

County owns and operates a non-potable irrigation water system in Wadsworth, Nevada. This irrigation water system was not transferred following the Washoe County Department of Water Resources Water Utility merger with the Truckee Meadows Water Authority.

PLPT owns and operates a municipal water system in the Wadsworth area that delivers potable-quality water in the town of Wadsworth. This system serves a large customer base of both tribal and non-tribal parcels of land surrounding the County system.

The County wants to transfer its Wadsworth irrigation water system (System), including the associated real property, infrastructure and equipment, and water rights (together the "Transferred Assets") to the PLPT who intend to consolidate the System with the PLPT's larger, potable water system. The System's infrastructure and equipment are further described in exhibit A. The real property associated with the System is further described in exhibit B. The water rights associated with the System are further described in exhibit C.

Upon acceptance of the System by the PLPT, irrigation water service will cease and the current irrigation water customers will be able to convert from irrigation water service to PLPT potable water service under the PLPT's terms and conditions for municipal water service, if the irrigation water customers choose to do so.

Under NRS 277.053, the County may convey real property to an Indian Tribe "without charge if the property is to be used for a public purpose." And, NRS 244.1505(2)(a) allows the County to donate equipment to another governmental entity to be used for "any purpose [that] will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the [C]ounty."

PLPT's combining the System with the PLPT's larger, potable-quality water system will eliminate the need for PLPT to construct duplicate water conveyance infrastructure in the Wadsworth area and provide current irrigation customers the option to convert to potable water service following the PLPT's rules and requirements for municipal water service.

Therefore, the parties agree as follows:

1. Incorporated Documents. The parties agree that the following documents are incorporated into this agreement:

Exhibit A – Wadsworth Irrigation Water System Infrastructure and Equipment Exhibit B – Wadsworth Irrigation Water System Real Property Exhibit C – Wadsworth Irrigation Water System Water Rights

2. Performance.

2.1. The County shall convey, and the PLPT shall incorporate into its water system, the County's Wadsworth irrigation water system, including the system's associated real property; infrastructure and equipment; and water rights, as described in exhibits A, B, and C, respectively.

2.2. County shall convey to the PLPT good and marketable title to all of the Transferred Assets, subject to no liens, mortgages, pledges, security interests, rights of third parties, encumbrances, or other charges of any kind.

2.3. After County coveys the Transferred Assets to PLPT, the PLPT shall offer potable water service to the customers currently using the System, subject to PLPT's rules and requirements for municipal water service. If said Irrigation customers choose not to become PLPT potable customers, they shall rely solely on their individual domestic wells as the source of water supply for all indoor and outdoor needs.

2.4. The parties shall execute a quitclaim deed conveying the real property described in exhibit B from the County to PLPT.

2.5. The parties shall execute a water-rights deed conveying the water described in exhibit C from County to PLPT.

3. Representations. County makes the following representations:

3.1. Real Property. County represents that it has no knowledge that title to the real property is defective and represents that, to the best of its knowledge, the real property is free and clear of all liens, mortgages, pledges, security interests, rights of third parties, encumbrances, or other charges of any kind that may materially interfere with or otherwise impair PLPT's ability to operate and maintain the System.

3.2. Water Rights. County represents that the water rights described in exhibit C represent the water rights owned by County that are necessary to operate the existing System. The water rights conveyed under this agreement are in an "AS IS, WHERE IS" condition.

3.3. Condition and Location of Infrastructure and Equipment. County represents that all of the System infrastructure and equipment are conveyed in an "AS IS, WHERE IS" condition, and County makes no warranties of merchantability, fitness, or fitness for a particular purpose with regard thereto.

4. Entire agreement. This agreement and its attachments constitute the entire understanding between the parties with respect to the subject matter of this contract and supersedes all other contracts, whether written or oral between the parties.

5. Effective date. This agreement becomes effective when all the parties have signed it. The date this agreement is signed by the last party to sign it (as indicated by the date stated beneath that party's signature) will be deemed the date of this agreement.
