SUBJECT: Recommendation to accept a Nevada Division of Emergency Management grant award [amount not to exceed \$7,000.00, no County match required] as administered through the State of Nevada Department of Public Safety Office, Division of Emergency Management, to deliver a Train-the-Trainer course to enable community members to become certified Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) Basic Instructors, for the retroactive grant period of September 1, 2019 through August 30, 2020 and if approved, direct Comptroller's Office to make the necessary budget amendments.
