TYPES OF RESPONSE

EMS: Medical, Auto Accident, Extrication, Rescue

Good Intent: Canceled, Controlled Burning, Smoke Report, No Emergency Found

Public Assist: Person in Distress, Unauthorized Burning, Assist Invalid, Animal Problem/Rescue

False Alarm: System Malfunction, Unintentional Alarm, Mischievous Alarm, False Report

Fire: Structure Fire, Wildland Fire, Vehicle Fire, Rubbish Fire.


Hazmat: Combustible Spill/Leak, Chemical Release, Electrical Problem, Bio Hazard

Rupture: The break or crack of a pipe/utility e.g.: gas leak, water main

Weather: Damage caused by weather related response e.g.: fallen tree
