**TRUCKEE MEADOWS FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT RESOLUTION
ADOPTING THE WASHOE COUNTY REGIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN.**

WHEREAS, Washoe County formed a Hazard Mitigation Steering Committee with the following regional partners: City of Sparks, City of Reno, Reno-Sparks Indian Colony, Pyramid Lake Paiute Tribe, Truckee River Flood Management Project, North Lake Tahoe Fire Protection District, and Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District (TMFPD); the efforts of this committee have resulted in the 2020 Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District in cooperation with Washoe County and other regional partners conducted a Hazard Vulnerability Analysis and integrated public input as part of this process to consider the natural, technological, and human caused risks to which TMFPD is vulnerable; and

WHEREAS, Recent events have shown TMFPD must remain ever vigilant to eliminate or reduce the risk to human life, property and the environment posed by hazards; and

WHEREAS, The Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan's purpose is to integrate hazard mitigation strategies into the activities and programs of TMFPD; and

WHEREAS, The Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan is a living document;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District Board of Fire Commissioners, on behalf of the residents of the Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District, adopt the Washoe County Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan, and further direct TMFPD to continue to inform the public and community of the hazard mitigation strategies recommended by the plan.
