SUBJECT: Recommendation to accept a 2020 Nevada State Emergency Response

Commission (SERC), United We Stand (UWS) grant for [\$30,000.00, no County match required]. Grant Term is retroactive to December 31, 2019 through June 30, 2020. If approved, authorize the Chairperson to execute grant documents and authorize the County Manager or his designee, to sign the Sub-Grant Agreement between Washoe County and the City of Reno in the amount of [\$19,075.15], and the Regional Emergency Medical Services Authority (REMSA) in the amount of [\$10,924.85:] approve Resolution necessary for same; and direct the Comptroller's Office to make the appropriate budget amendments. (All Commission Districts)

#### **SUMMARY**

Washoe County Board of County Commissioners (BCC) is requested to accept a 2020 SERC, UWS grant for [\$30,000.00, no County match required]. The Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC) will subgrant these funds to member entities to provide equipment and technological upgrades to local first responders strengthening their ability to effectively respond to acts of terrorism.

Staff is requesting a retroactive approval to December 31, 2019 due to the timing of the receipt of the grant award and timing of BCC meeting opportunities.

Washoe County Strategic Objective supported by this item: Safe, secure and healthy communities.

#### **PREVIOUS ACTION**

**September 11, 2018** – The Board of County Commissioners approved a 2019 SERC UWS grant for \$25,000.00.

October 24, 2017 – The Board of County Commissioners approved a 2018 SERC UWS grant for \$24,920.00.

**August 9, 2016** – The Board of County Commissioners approved a 2017 SERC UWS grant for \$24,887.00.

**August 12, 2014** – The Board of County Commissioners approved a 2015 SERC UWS Grant for \$30,000.00.

The BCC has accepted this award annually for 12 of the past 13 years.

#### **BACKGROUND**

The source of this funding is derived from fees collected from the sale and annual renewal of the United We Stand specialty license plates. The grant provides funding to the Washoe County Local Emergency Planning Committee for Planning, Training and Equipment purchases. The grant funding intent is to improve state and local government planning, training and response capabilities to react to Acts of Terrorism.

#### **GRANT AWARD SUMMARY**

**Project/Program Name:** 2020 Nevada State Emergency Response Commission

**Scope of the Project:** *To support preparedness to combat terrorism.* 

**Benefit to Washoe County Residents:** The grant will benefit our regional first responders by providing the equipment necessary to conduct an effective response to Acts of Terrorism, protecting the lives and properties of County residents.

**On-Going Program Support:** This annual grant opportunity is for specific deliverables. We will continue to apply for funding annually.

#### **Sub-Awards and Contracts:**

Washoe County will subgrant \$10,924.85 of these funds to REMSA for response equipment and will sub-grant \$19,075.15 of these funds to the City of Reno for training equipment for the Reno Fire Department and technological upgrades for the Reno Police Department.

Should the board accept this grant award and approve these amendments, the FY 20 Emergency Management adopted budget will be increased by \$30,000.00 in both revenues and expenditures in the following accounts:
