RESOLUTION – Authorizing the Grant of Public Monies to a Government Entity

WHEREAS, NRS 244.1505 provides that a Board of County Commissioners may expend money for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County and that a board may make a grant of money to a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes or to a governmental entity to be expended for a selected purpose; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County upon the recommendation of Commissioner Jeanne Herman for District 5, has determined that \$5,000 will be granted to Washoe County Emergency Management for the purchase of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) as part of the community response to the Covid 19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, personal protective equipment (PPE) refers to protective clothing, helmets, gloves, face shields, goggles, facemasks and/or respirators or other equipment designed to protect the wearer from the spread of infection or illness; and

WHEREAS, Washoe County Emergency Management, in concert with the regional Incident Management Team is coordinating the purchase of PPE for the region and will use the funds donated to continue to add to support the safety of our community during the Covid 19 pandemic, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County that:

- 1. The Board hereby grants to Washoe County Emergency Management a grant for fiscal year 2019-2020 in the amount of \$5,000.
- 2. The Board finds that in making this grant a substantial benefit will be provided to the inhabitants of Washoe County by supporting the organization's response to the Covid 19 pandemic.
- 3. Funds shall not be used for the purchase of tickets to special events.
