<u>RESOLUTION</u> – Authorizing the Grant of Public Monies to a Nonprofit Organization Created for Religious, Charitable or Educational Purposes

WHEREAS, NRS 244.1505 provides that a Board of County Commissioners may expend money for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County and that a board may make a grant of money to a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes or to a governmental entity to be expended for a selected purpose; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County upon the recommendation of Commissioner Jeanne Herman for District 5, has determined that \$2,000 will be granted to The Salvation Army of Washoe County to support to support Men's Adult Rehabilitation Program; and

WHEREAS, Since 1865, The Salvation Army has been pursuing their mission of "Doing the most good." They are committed to these four words that sum up their mission: to feed, to clothe, to comfort, to care, to bring light, and to provide the services that help sustain our communities; and

WHEREAS, The Adult Rehabilitation Program (ARP) is a place of hope and new beginnings dedicated to rebuilding the lives of men who are dealing with substance abuse, homelessness and other serious life problems. A 70-bed facility, the minimum stay for a man in need is six months. Admission is voluntary, and services are provided free of cost for the participant; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County that:

- 1. The Board finds that in making this grant a substantial benefit will be provided to the inhabitants of the County by supporting the Salvation Army's Men's Adult Rehabilitation Program.
- 2. The Board hereby grants to The Salvation Army of Washoe County a grant for fiscal year 2019-2020 in the amount of \$2,000.
- 3. Funds shall not be used for the purchase of tickets to special events.
