RESOLUTION – Authorizing the Grant of Public Monies to a Nonprofit Organization Created for Religious, Charitable or Educational Purposes.

WHEREAS, NRS 244.1505 provides that a Board of County Commissioners may expend money for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County and that a board may make a grant of money to a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes or to a governmental entity to be expended for a selected purpose; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County upon the recommendation of Commissioner Jeanne Herman for District 5, has determined that \$2,000 will be granted to Saving Grace Academy to support purchase of playground equipment and pay for Washoe County permits; and

WHEREAS, Saving Grace Academy is a is a nonprofit Christian preschool and daycare located in Lemmon Valley, Nevada. The preschool and daycare will be licensed by Washoe County Childcare Licensing; and

WHEREAS, Saving Grace Academy is committed to providing high quality, low cost childcare to Lemmon Valley residents; by employing a Montessori curriculum where the children can have one on one assistance, with a focus on math, reading, dramatic play, science, small motor skills and large motor skills. They will be taught beginning words in Spanish and American Sign Language; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County that:

- 1. The Board finds that in making this grant a substantial benefit will be provided to the inhabitants in Washoe County by supporting the Saving Grace Academy preschool and daycare.
- 2. The Board hereby grants to Saving Grace Academy a grant for fiscal year 2019-2020 in the amount of \$2,000 to support Saving Grace Academy.
- 3. Funds shall not be used for the purchase of tickets to special events.
