RESOLUTION R20-056: Authorizing grant of funds to Washoe County School District

WHEREAS, NRS 244.1505 provides that a board of county commissioners may expend money for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the county and that a board may make a grant of money to a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes, or other governmental entity, to be expended for a selected purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County has determined that a certain amount of money is available from the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act, Coronavirus Relief Fund, CFDA #20.019, passed through the State of Nevada Governor's Finance Office, will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of Washoe County;

NOW, THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY, that the Board hereby grants to the Washoe County School District for the purposes set forth in the Subgrant Agreement.

- 1. The Board hereby grants to the Washoe County School District, a grant in the amount of \$72,314.
- 2. The purpose of the CRF-CARES funded program is to provide training and support Employee Health Nurses.
- 3. The maximum amount to be expended from the grant and the conditions and limitations upon the grant are set forth in the Subgrant Agreement.
