SUBJECT:	Recommendation to accept grant funding [\$62,632.00 with no county match] from the State of Nevada Department of Health and Human Services for personnel, operating, and travel expenses relating to the National Violent Death Reporting System (NVDRS), retroactive from September 1, 2020 through August 31, 2021, and authorize the Chief Medical Examiner & Coroner of the Washoe County Regional Medical Examiner's Office to sign the award and approve amendments, and direct the Comptroller's Office to make the necessary budget amendments. # **SUMMARY**

This grant will allow for paid staff time (including fringe and benefits), travel, and operating expenses to investigate violent deaths and input data into the National Violent Death Reporting System (NVDRS). This is the fifth year the Regional Medical Examiner's Office has received this grant.

October 8, 2019 – Board acceptance of NVDRS grant funding of 67,000 for FY20 and FY21

# BACKGROUND

The grant is retroactive from September 1, 2020 due to not receiving the grant award paperwork from the State of Nevada until mid-October 2020.

## GRANT AWARD SUMMARY

**Project/Program Name:** National Violent Death Reporting System (NVDRS)

**Scope of the Project:** Provides for personnel, operating, and travel expenses to investigate violent deaths and receive training for the National Violent Death Reporting System

**Benefit to Washoe County Residents:** The National Violent Death Reporting System is a detailed data repository for all violent deaths. This data can be used by law enforcement, health agencies, etc. to better understand the causes of violent deaths. The data can also be used in suicide prevention and domestic violence prevention programs.

**On-Going Program Support:** This is the fifth year of the program created by the federal government and will continue as long as grant funding is available.

## FISCAL IMPACT

Expenses for this grant will be reimbursed to Washoe County from the State of Nevada after they are incurred. The Regional Medical Examiner's Office has sufficient budget to pay the expenses until reimbursement occurs. No match is required for this grant. As this award funds personnel, if grant funding is reduced or eliminated, the position hours will be reduced and/or the position abolished accordingly, unless additional funding is secured. Should the board accept this grant award, the Fiscal Year 2021 adopted budget for the Regional Medical Examiner's Office will be increased by \$62,632.00 in both revenues and expenditures in the following accounts:
