SUMMARY

This grant has been awarded to cover new Polycom Systems and a U-Temp temperature screening unit. These items will allow the Sheriffs' Office to better operate from a distance and perform temperature checks without direct person to person contact. These necessities are a direct result of the COVID-19 pandemic.

BACKGROUND

The Washoe County Sheriff's Office has been awarded a grant with the Nevada Office of Criminal Justice Assistance to purchase new Polycom Systems for our arraignment rooms as well as a U-Temp temperature monitoring stations for the entrances to our building. This grant will pay for the purchase of the Polycom Systems and the U-Temp units throughout the grant period of January 20, 2020 through June 30, 2021. Reason for retroactive submittal: Item was submitted to the first available BCC meeting once paperwork was received and processed.
