Authorizing grant of funds to the Food Bank of Northern Nevada

WHEREAS, NRS 244.1505 provides that a board of county commissioners may expend money for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the county and that a board may make a grant of money to a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes, or other governmental entity, to be expended for a selected purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County has determined that a certain amount of money is available from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) States Program, CFDA #14.228, passed through the Nevada Governor's Office on Economic Development, State award number CDBG-CV 20/PS/05, will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of Washoe County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY, that the Board hereby grants to the Food Bank of Northern Nevada for the purposes set forth in the Sub-Grant Agreement.

- 1. The Board hereby grants to the Food Bank of Northern Nevada, a grant in the amount of \$144,300.
- 2. The purpose of the CDBG funded program is to increase food distribution across Northern Nevada by expanding its warehouse space with additional racking and conduct a survey of effect COVID-19 has had on food insecurities.
- 3. The maximum amount to be expended from the grant and the conditions and limitations upon the grant are set forth in the Sub-grant Agreement.
