

RESOLUTION: R20-061

Authorizing grant of funds to the Food Bank of Northern Nevada

WHEREAS, NRS 244.1505 provides that a board of county commissioners may expend money for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the county and that a board may make a grant of money to a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes, or other governmental entity, to be expended for a selected purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County has determined that a certain amount of money is available from the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act, Coronavirus Relief Fund, CFDA #20.019, passed through the State of Nevada Governor's Finance Office, and increased distribution of food to residents experiencing food insecurity will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of Washoe County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY, that the Board hereby grants to the Food Bank of Northern Nevada for the purposes set forth in the Subgrant Agreement.

1. The Board hereby grants to the Food Bank of Northern Nevada, a grant in the amount of \$76,500.
2. The purpose of the CRF-CARES funded program is to increase core food distribution and Mobile Harvests, and provide supplemental home delivered meals for seniors.
3. The maximum amount to be expended from the grant and the conditions and limitations upon the grant are set forth in the Subgrant Agreement.
