Performance Grant (EMPG) from the State of Nevada, Division of Emergency Management (NDEM) awarding [\$170,877.00 (\$170,877.00 County match required)] to be used for partial funding for the Washoe County Emergency Management Administrator, consulting services for avalanche and weather advisory services, and other operating expenses for the Regional Emergency Operations Center; retroactive from October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2021; if approved authorize the County

SUMMARY

Washoe County Board of County Commissioners is requested to approve the acceptance of a FFY 2020 Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) from the State of Nevada, Division of Emergency Management (NDEM) awarding [\$170,877.00 (\$170,877.00 County match required)].

The Board annually accepts the Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) to fund a portion of the County's Emergency Management program. The State of Nevada, Division of Emergency Management has provided this grant award to Washoe County for more than 17 years. The EMPG program provides funding to assist local governments to sustain and enhance all-hazards emergency management activities.

This grant is retroactive due to the delay of the US Department of Homeland Security releasing the funds to the Nevada Division of Emergency Management.

Washoe County Strategic Objective supported by this item: Support a Thriving Community

PREVIOUS ACTION

August 18, 2020 - The Board of County Commissioners accepted a Letter of Intent for an 2020 EMPG from the State of Nevada, Department of Emergency Management for \$170,877.00 [with a County match of \$170,877.00]; and directed the Comptroller's Office to make the appropriate budget amendments.

November 12, 2019 - The Board approved the letter of intent from NDEM to award \$170,877.00 for EMPG and directed the comptroller to make the necessary budget amendments.

November 13, 2018 – The Board of County Commissioners accepted a Letter of Intent for an 2018 EMPG from the State of Nevada, Department of Emergency Management for \$170,877.00 [with a County match of \$170,877.00]; and directed the Comptroller's Office to make the appropriate budget amendments.

The Board has approved this grant for the past 17 years.

BACKGROUND

This grant provides partial funding for the Washoe County Emergency Management Administrator position, consulting services for avalanche and weather advisory services, plan updates, training, supplies, and operating expenses for the Regional Emergency Operations Center.

This grant requires a 100% match.

GRANT AWARD SUMMARY

Project/Program Name: FFY2020 Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG)

Scope of the Project: The EMPG program provides funding to assist local governments to sustain and enhance all-hazards emergency management capabilities.

Benefit to Washoe County Residents: The benefit of this funding is for emergency preparedness for the protection of life and property in the region from hazards and disasters.

On-Going Program Support: We will continue to seek grant funding to sustain the Emergency Management program.

FISCAL IMPACT

The FFY 2020 EMPG award amount totals \$170,877 for the period October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2021, with the personnel category performance period retroactive from October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2020. In FY20, there were \$58,630.19 in actual expenditures and budget expenditure authority of \$112,246.81 has been accounted for in the FY 21 budget within Internal Order 11634.

This grant requires a 100% cost share (50% federal and 50% county match). The County will provide \$106,051.61 in CC 155110 and \$64,825.39 from WCSO CC 150680, total \$170,877.00. No indirect costs are being recovered.

As this award funds personnel, if grant funding is reduced or eliminated, the position hours will be reduced and/or the positions abolished accordingly, unless additional funding is secured.
