The Washoe County Safety Committee regularly reviews safety-related policies to comply with Nevada Revised Statutes and for the safety of employees, and members of the public. These tools are provided to identify, correct, and/or control identified hazards and may be updated as necessary.

PREVIOUS ACTION

The Driver Policy was last approved by the Board of County Commissioners on October 23, 2018.

The Washoe County Emergency Action Plan Policy was last approved by the Board of County Commissioners on October 28, 2014.

The Washoe County Workplace Safety Program was last approved by the Board of County Commissioners on October 22, 2013.

BACKGROUND

Per County Code 65.150 a Safety Committee meeting is created to include the communication of safety policies to all employees and volunteers. Pursuant to NRS 618 and Washoe County Code 65.060(3) all employers in Nevada must establish a written safety program containing such matters as are covered in NRS 618.383. The Washoe County Safety Committee members suggested clarification and updating of some issues including how training is conducted and increased communication. On March 18, 2021 the Washoe County Safety Committee voted to accept the suggested changes, updated
