 - **SUBJECT:** Recommendation to approve funding [\$3,023.00, no match required], provided by the U.S. Department of Justice, United States Marshals Service (USMS) to reimburse the Washoe County Sheriff's Office for overtime costs associated with the United States Marshals Service Task Force and the Regional Sex Offender Notification Unit for the Sex Offender Compliance Sweep (Operation SOS) for the retroactive grant period of April 1, 2021 through June 30, 2021. (All Commission Districts.)

SUMMARY

This funding is intended to reimburse the Washoe County Sheriff's Office for overtime costs for staff that are involved with Operation SOS in conjunction with the USMS Task Force and the Regional Sex Offender Notification Unit while they are engaged in task force activities.

Washoe County Strategic Objective supported by this item: Safe, Secure and Healthy communities.

PREVIOUS ACTION

On August 8, 2017, the Board approved item number 6.J.1., reimbursement provided by the U.S. Department of Justice, United States Marshal's Service (USMS) for overtime costs associated with Operation SOS in the amount of \$910.02.

On September 13, 2016, the Board approved item number 6.E.3, reimbursement provided by the U.S. Department of Justice, United States Marshal's Service (USMS) for overtime costs associated with Operation SOS in the amount of \$1,219.21.

On May 10, 2016, the Board approved item number 5.B, reimbursement provided by the U.S. Department of Justice, United States Marshal's Service (USMS) for overtime costs associated with Operation SOS in the amount of \$2,130.00.

The Board has been approving reimbursement for Operation SOS since 2013.

BACKGROUND

The U.S. Department of Justice, United States Marshals Service provides funding to reimburse the Sheriff's Office for overtime for staff involved in Operation SOS. Retroactive submittal: Item was submitted to the first available BCC meeting once paperwork was received and processed.
