HIGHLIGHTS

Instructor at TMCC for 10 of the last 12 years as a part-time instructor teaching dentistry and emergency and critical care for the Veterinary Technician Program. In the fall semester of 2019, I became a full-time instructor for the VT Program and am currently in the first year of my tenure track program. In addition to teaching at TMCC, I have been educating veterinarians, technicians, and support staff in veterinary practices, laboratory and conference settings since 2005.

I have more than 20 years' experience with the ability to provide quality patient care, anesthesia, advanced imaging, and advanced dentistry. This includes many species of animals, including canine, feline, avian, small mammal, reptile, and equine species.

Obtained my Veterinary Technician Specialty (VTS) in Dentistry in 2008 from the Academy of Veterinary Dental Technicians. I am one of only 93 in the United States and 99 worldwide. This has led to my ability to continue to share my passion for dentistry to veterinarians and technicians. I am contracted with Midmark Animal Health as a VTS trainer and travel the western US to train proper dental techniques and radiology and have traveled to 17 locations in 2020.

I am a contributing author to the text *Small Animal Dental Procedures for Veterinary Technicians and Nurses*, Perrone, Jeanne R., Wiley-Blackwell, 2013. The updated edition is due to be released in September 2020. This text is used as a teaching text in many technician programs, including TMCC.

I have a thorough knowledge of modern technology, office practices, and procedures related to the veterinary field. Proficient with current technology needed to instruct students successfully. I am continuing my education related to instruction - this includes Canvas, Starfish, and QM training.
