#### **SUMMARY**

#### **PREVIOUS ACTION**

On May 28, 2019 the Board approved the Purchasing and Contracts Manager to join onto UNLV's contract, number 7885, with My Next Career Path through February 2022.

#### **BACKGROUND**

Washoe County joined onto UNLV's contract, number 7885, My Next Career Path through February 2022. The Board of County Commissioners approved the current agreements at their May 28, 2019 meeting.

The Health District's FY22 purchase's support various positions of our COVID-19 response efforts (administrative and testing) and support of current COVID-19 vaccination events. Utilizing temporary employment services has proven to be an efficient and effective method of providing surge staffing in several programs.
