SUMMARY

The Washoe Board of County Commissioners must approve amendments to the adopted fiscal year budget and direct the Comptroller's Office to make the appropriate budget amendments.

Washoe County Strategic Objective supported by this item: Fiscal Sustainability.

PREVIOUS ACTION

The Board approved the FY22 budget on May 18, 2021.

The District Board of Health accepted this subaward at their July 22, 2021 meeting.

BACKGROUND

This Award supports the Public Health Preparedness Program which writes plans that will guide the Health District's response to public health emergencies such as bioterrorism and natural disasters. The program also coordinates and participates in trainings, drills and exercises to test those plans and increase the ability to respond to such emergencies.

The Subaward provides funding for personnel, operating, contractual, other, and indirect expenditures.

GRANT AWARD SUMMARY

Project/Program Name: Public Health Preparedness (PHP) Program

Scope of the Project: This Subaward provides funding intended to demonstrate achievement in the Public Health Emergency Preparedness (PHEP) program domains according to the PHEP Cooperative Agreement.

Benefit to Washoe County Residents: This Award supports the Epidemiology and Public Health Preparedness (EPHP) Division's mission to strengthen the capacity of public health infrastructure to detect, assess and respond decisively to control the public health consequences of bioterrorism events or any public health emergency.

On-Going Program Support: These funds support on-going activities in the Public Health Preparedness Program.

FISCAL IMPACT

As the FY22 budget was adopted with a total of \$935,680 in revenue (includes \$170,861 in indirect) and \$764,819 in expenditure authority, a budget amendment in the amount of \$10,245 is necessary to bring the Notice of Subgrant Award into alignment with the direct program budget.

No amendment is necessary for indirect revenue.

Should the BCC approve these budget amendments, the FY22 budget will be increased by \$10,245 in the following accounts:
