SUMMARY

Accept donations in the amount of \$11,664.05 in cash and in-kind donations [estimated value \$174,565.00] from various businesses, organizations and individuals for Regional Parks and Open Space programs and facilities, retroactive to date of receipt.

Washoe County Strategic Objective supported by this item: Stewardship of our Community

PREVIOUS ACTION

Donations are made to the Regional Parks and Open Space programs and facilities and formally accepted by the Board of County Commissioners.

BACKGROUND

The residents of Washoe County support our parks, open space and natural resources through their generous cash contributions, donations of materials, supplies and services and volunteer time. Cash donations, in the amount of \$11,664.05 and in-kind donations [estimated value \$174,565.00] have been received for park maintenance, improvements, programming, and to assist with the safety and comfort for Washoe County residents, therefore, retroactive approval to accept these donations is being sought.

Cash donations received at this time are dedicated to the operations and maintenance support for the Lazy 5 Summer Music Series, The Hive at Lazy 5, general donations to the May Museum and for May Arboretum garden memorial brick(s), tree pruning, a memorial tree, maintenance, and improvements.

Estimated values of various in-kind donations received include:

May Arboretum tree pruning and removal from the May Arboretum Society [\$8,425.00]

May Arboretum memorial bricks shipping costs donated from Granite Mountain [\$250.00]

May Arboretum flowers and seeds from Paula Starkey, individual [\$400.00]

A side by side refrigerator for the Hawkins Amphitheater from Steven Moss, individual [\$800.00]
