

**RESOLUTION: R26-000045**

Authorizing an award of funds to Northern Nevada HOPES

**WHEREAS**, NRS 244.1505 provides that a Board of County Commissioners may expend money for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County and that a board may make a grant of money to certain nonprofit organizations or governmental entities created for religious, charitable or educational purposes; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County has determined that a certain amount of money is available from the Washoe Opioid Abatement and Recovery Funds (WOARF), award number WOARF27-00004, through the One Nevada Agreement on Allocation of Opioid Recoveries, passed through to Northern Nevada HOPES for the Hope Springs- Bridge Housing and Recovery Services for Unhoused Opioid Users program will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of Washoe County;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY**, that the Board hereby awards

1. Northern Nevada HOPES, a grant in the amount of \$995,626.93.
2. The purpose of Hope Springs- Bridge Housing and Recovery Services for Unhoused Opioid Users is to provide a tiny home, transitional housing program will utilize a Housing-First and Behavioral Health Focused model to provide unhoused persons who use opioids with on-site individual/ group behavioral health treatment, case management, Peer Support Services, workforce development, financial coaching, and wrap-around services that help them access/sustain housing.
3. The maximum amount to be expended from the grant and the conditions and limitations upon the award are set forth in Notice of Award WOARF27-00004 that will be signed by the County Manager, or designee.
