District Special Fund disbursement in the amount of [\$15,000.00] for Fiscal Year 2023-2024; District Commissioner Mariluz Garcia recommends a [\$5,000.00] grant to Be the Change Project -- a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes -- to work with artists and kids to make murals and sculptures providing art to the community; a [\$5,000.00] grant to Nevada Museum of Art - a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes -- to support the new Education and Research Center; a [\$5,000.00] grant to Domestic Violence Resource Center-- a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes -- to support their emergency shelter and transitional housing residents; approve Resolutions necessary for same; and direct the Comptroller's Office to make the necessary disbursements of funds. District 3).

SUMMARY

This item requests the Board to approve resolutions and disburse district funds in the total amount of [\$15,000.00] for Commission District 3.

PREVIOUS ACTION

On August 15, 2023, the Board of County Commissioners directed [\$5,000.00] to Noah's Animal House – a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes – to support the organization's mission to provide on-site pet shelter and care for victims of domestic violence.

BACKGROUND

Modification of guidelines and adoption of resolution for County Commission District Special Funding on February 10, 2015 created Commission District Special Funds for each Commission District. On May 16, 2023 the Board of County Commissioners approved the 2023-2024 fiscal year budget with special district funds allocated per Commission District in the amount of \$100,000.00. The monies appropriated are to support needs for all Washoe County residents.

Funds appropriated through the Commission District Special Funds must provide substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County. The recipient must be a non-profit organization, created for religious, charitable, or educational purposes, or a government entity. Funds shall not provide any personal or private benefit for the Commissioners, directly or indirectly benefit any campaign efforts by a commissioner, violate Ethics in Government law, or be used to purchase tickets to special events.

Commissioner Garcia has elected to support the following organization in fiscal year 2023-2024:

- [\$5,000.00] grant to Be the Change Project -- a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes -- to work with artists and kids to make murals and sculptures providing art to the community.
- [\$5,000.00] grant to Nevada Museum of Art a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes -- to support the new Education and Research Center.
- [\$5,000.00] grant to Domestic Violence Resource Center -- a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes -- to support their emergency shelter and transitional housing residents.

FISCAL IMPACT

Sufficient FY23-24 budget authority exists within the Cost Center District 3 Constituents (C100103) and account Payments to other Agencies (710400). This action requests approval and distribution of a [total of \$15,000.00] to Be the Change Project, Nevada Museum of Art, and Domestic Violence Resource Center.

Expense Disbursements are required as follows:

• Be the Change Project: \$5,000.00

• Nevada Museum of Art: \$5,000.00

• Domestic Violence Resource Center: \$5,000.00
