WASHOE COUNTY RESOLUTION R25-35



WHEREAS, Washoe County formed a Hazard Mitigation Steering Committee with regional partners (the Cities of Sparks and Reno, The Reno-Sparks Indian Colony, the Pyramid Lake Paiute tribe, the Truckee River Flood Management Authority, the Truckee Meadows Fire Protection District and the North Lake Fire Protection District) and the efforts of this committee have resulted in the 2025 Washoe County Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

WHEREAS, Washoe County, regional partners and stakeholders, working in partnership with a vendor, completed vulnerability and capability assessments and solicited and integrated public input as part of this process, to ensure consideration of natural, human-caused and technological threats and hazards to which the County is vulnerable; and

WHEREAS, recent events have shown that the County must remain ever vigilant to prepare for, mitigate against, respond to, and recover from hazards while eliminating or reducing the risk to human life, property and the environment; and

WHEREAS, The Washoe County Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan is a living document;

NOW, THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHOE COUNTY, that the Board, on behalf of the residents of Washoe County, adopt the Washoe County Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan, and further direct that the County Emergency Manager continue to inform the public and community of the hazard mitigation strategies recommended by the plan.
