

RESOLUTION – Authorizing the Grant of Public Monies to a Nonprofit Organization Created for Religious, Charitable or Educational Purposes.

WHEREAS, NRS 244.1505 provides that a Board of County Commissioners may expend money for any purpose which will provide a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of the County and that a board may make a grant of money to a nonprofit organization created for religious, charitable or educational purposes or to a governmental entity to be expended for a selected purpose; and

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners of Washoe County upon the recommendation of Commissioner Bob Lucey for District 2, has determined that \$4,000.00 will be granted to Mustangs Wrestling Club; and

WHEREAS, to support area youth in efforts to teach discipline, self-confidence and inner strength to overcome obstacles; and

WHEREAS, Youth wrestling programs such as Mustangs Wrestling Club provide a safe and fun environment for both individual growth and team building, crucial skills for use throughout participants' entire lives; and

WHEREAS, Mustangs Wrestling Club provides opportunities for youth to learn about sportsmanship and respecting opponents; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the Board of Commissioners of Washoe County that:

1. The Board hereby grants to Mustang's Wrestling Club, a grant for fiscal year 2022-2023 in the amount of \$4,000.00.
2. The Board finds that in making this grant a substantial benefit will be provided to the residents in Washoe County by providing area youth personal and athletic growth opportunities that will impact them as future leaders throughout their lifetimes.
3. The funds shall not be used to purchase tickets to special events.
