- Whereas,** registering to vote empowers eligible citizens to exercise their right to vote and have a voice in the electoral process promoting civic engagement; and
- Whereas,** Washoe County has over 346,800 registered voters which continues to increase as our community grows; and
- Whereas,** the voter registration process in Nevada, and in Washoe County, is now easier and more convenient than ever with in-person registration available at the Office of the Registrar of Voters, voter registration applications available at local libraries, post offices, at state voter registration agencies, and through online voter registration available at RegisterToVoteNV.gov; and

- Whereas,** Americans across the nation have celebrated National Voter Registration Day on the fourth Tuesday in September, serving as a single day where we reaffirm a strong sense of civic pride and encourage our fellow citizens to register to vote.
