The existing point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 33, T.20N. R.22E. MDM, Storey County, Nevada, from which point the W $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 33 bears South 40° 39' west, 3395.0 feet.

The purpose of this Application is to provide return flow in the Truckee River at the Vista Gage equivalent to treated effluent from the Truckee Meadows Water Reclamation Facility (TMWRF) that is delivered to treated effluent reuse customers, pursuant to secondary permits issued for the use of the surface water component of treated effluent granted under Permit No. 29973.

Water under this Application will be used to provide return flow related to effluent reuse by existing and future customers. As the original decreed point of diversion is below Vista Gage the entire amount of this water right 1,400 AF will be available for return flow purposes as allowed under the Truckee River Operating Agreement. This application would move the point of diversion up to Steamboat Canal, where it would have been diverted for other purposes. However, as noted, the water will remain in the Truckee River.

This application is to ensure that there is no less water than would be present at the Vista Gage had the treated effluent been discharged to the Truckee River and not been delivered to the effluent customers. The surface water component of the secondary under Permit No. 29973 will be limited to the total of all similar applications granted by the State Engineer.

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
