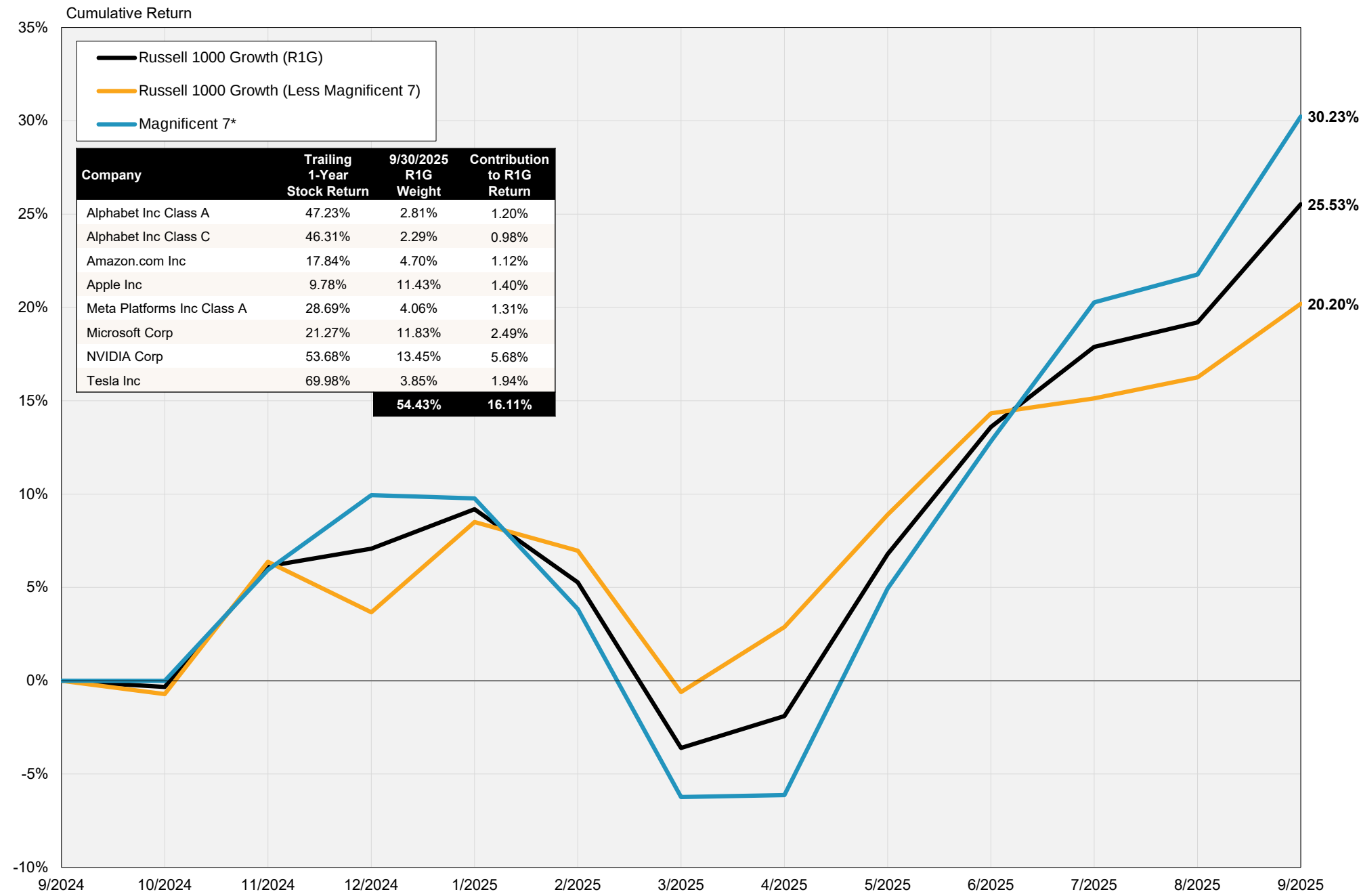


What's Driving the Performance of the Russell 1000 Growth Index? | Magnificent 7 and the Russell 1000 Growth Index
