On a sale transaction, the investor rate is Seventy Percent (70%) of the basic rate. This reduction does not apply to any surcharge calculated on the basic rate. On a refinance transaction or where the investor is obtaining a loan subsequent to a purchase, the rate shall be Eighty-Five Percent (85%) of the applicable rate with a minimum charge of Three Hundred Eighty-Five and No/100 Dollars (\$385.00). The loan discount shall only apply to transactions priced under Section 5.1 B (1b) of the title insurance rate manual. This rate is available upon request only.

**Available Escrow Discounts** These discounts will apply only to the escrow fee portion of your settlement charges, and the discounts will apply only if the company is issuing a policy of title insurance in conjunction with providing escrow services.

### **SENIOR CITIZEN RATE**

If a valid identification is provided, principals to a given transaction who qualify as Senior Citizens (55 year of age and over) shall be Seventy-Five Percent (75%) of their portion of the escrow fee wherein a valid identification is provided. 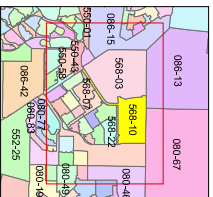
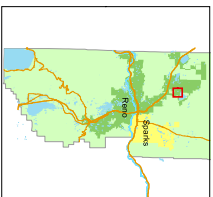
