SUMMARY

Northern Nevada Public Health received the Notice of Subaward on May 14, 2024, from the State of Nevada Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public and Behavioral Health in support of the CDC Epidemiology and Laboratory Capacity Grant Program. The funding period is retroactive to July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024. A copy of the Subaward is attached.

PREVIOUS ACTION

On September 28, 2023, the Board approved the Notice of Subaward for the Epidemiology and Laboratory Capacity Grant Program.

BACKGROUND

This Award supports the Epidemiology and Public Health Preparedness (EPHP) Division's Epidemiology Program by enhancing the capacity to effectively detect, respond, prevent, and control known and emerging (or re-emerging) infectious diseases. Funding supports staff to investigate, follow up and analyze communicable disease reports.
